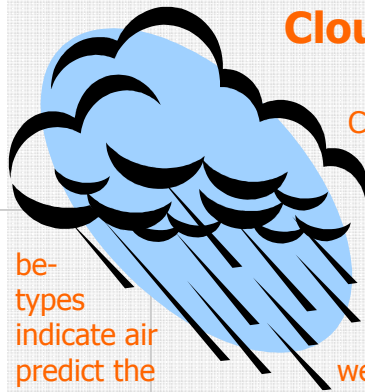
Study Math Facts. This is crucial!

We have begun multiplication! The review is over and the application is upon us! Fourth grade uses the facts that should have been learned in third grade to solve problems and work out complicated two and three digit multiplication products. There is no substitute for memorization! Make flash cards and tape these to the bathroom mirror, across from the toilet, place them under the dinner table glass. Ask your child multiplication facts in the car on the way to school, practice, and Scouts!

These facts are arranged in families just like addition and subtraction. Recite the multiplication and division fact families incessantly. As parents, we are tired of hearing these rote repetitions. It is really important for your child to hear the chanting. This will help the student to recall the fact when it is needed at school.

Sing the facts, rent the old, moldy multiplication rock DVD/Videos. I cannot stress how important immediate recall of multiplication facts and the fact families is to success.
